Other features include a 100-sheet document feeder, clear electronic endorsements for 100% legibility, a double check detector that virtually eliminates double check feeding and a built-in franker that prints a static message on checks to prevent double processing. Two-pocket support offers flexibility when separating documents such as checks and payment

coupons. In addition to being the only check scanner available with a two-year warranty, Epson provides overnight replacement options to minimize downtime.
